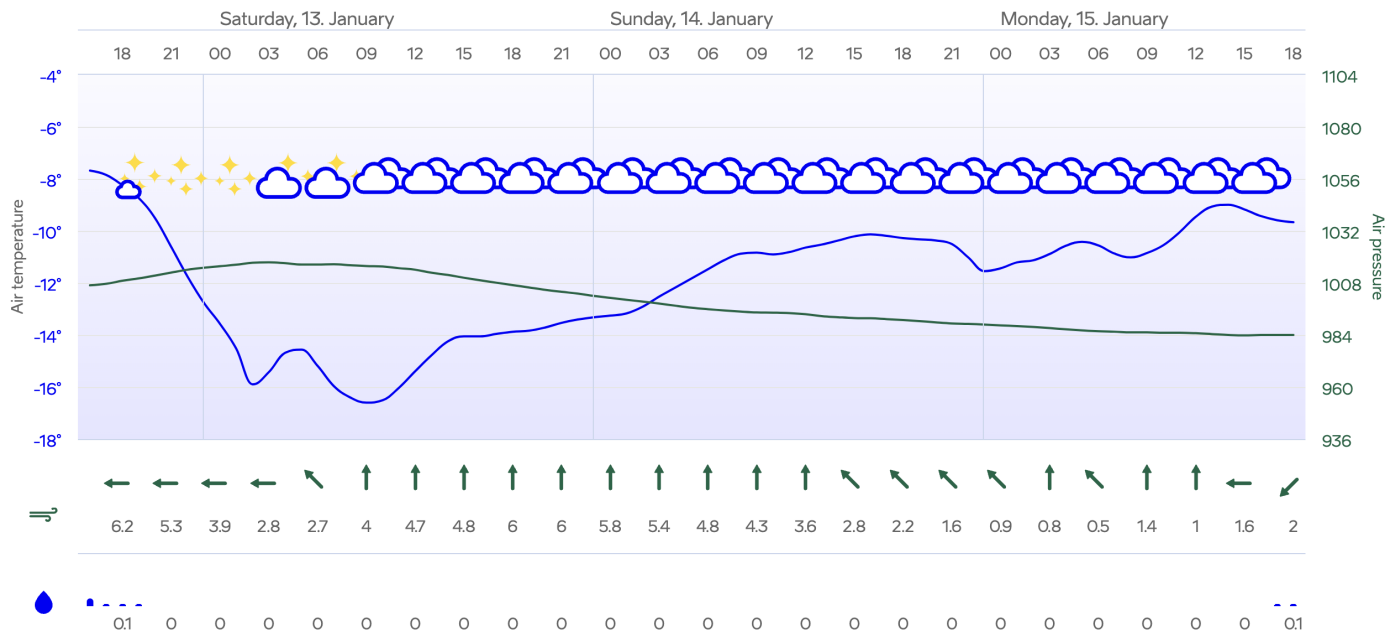

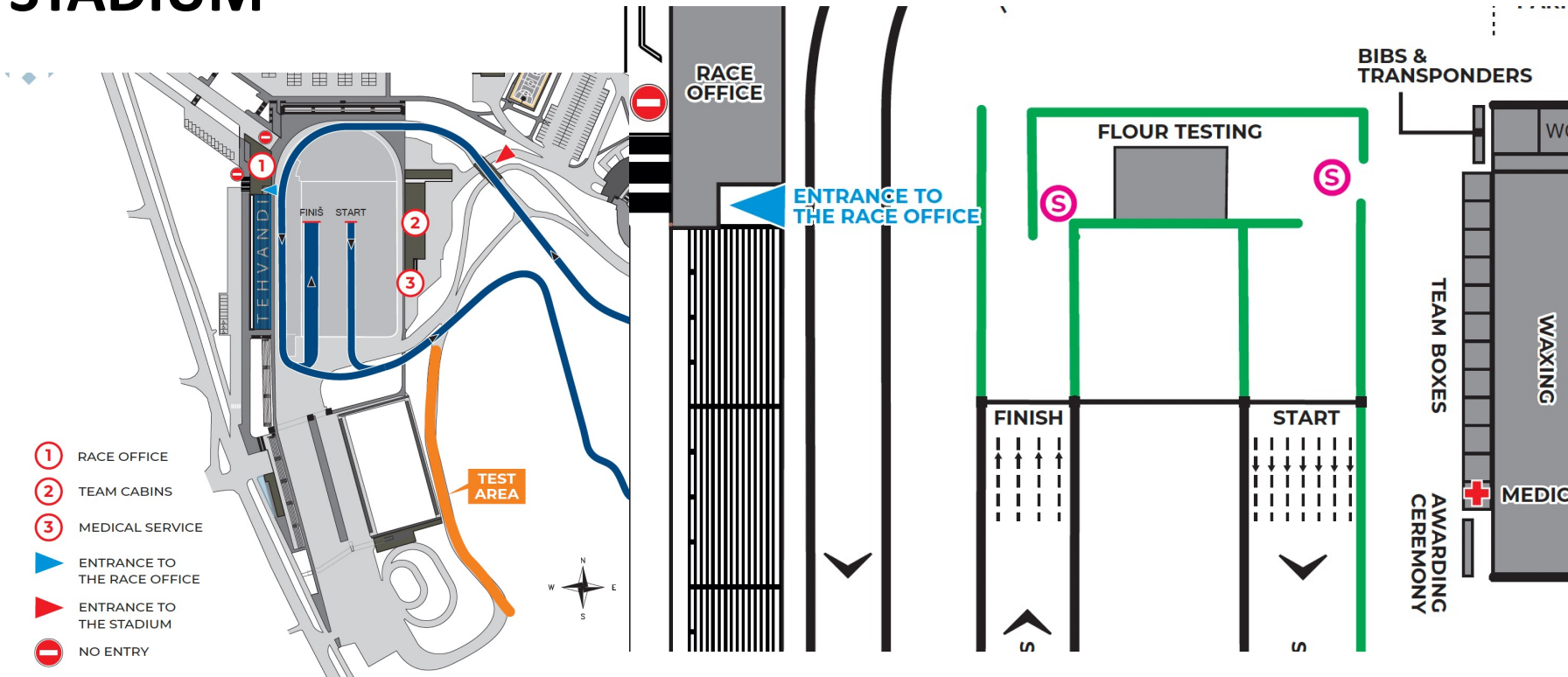

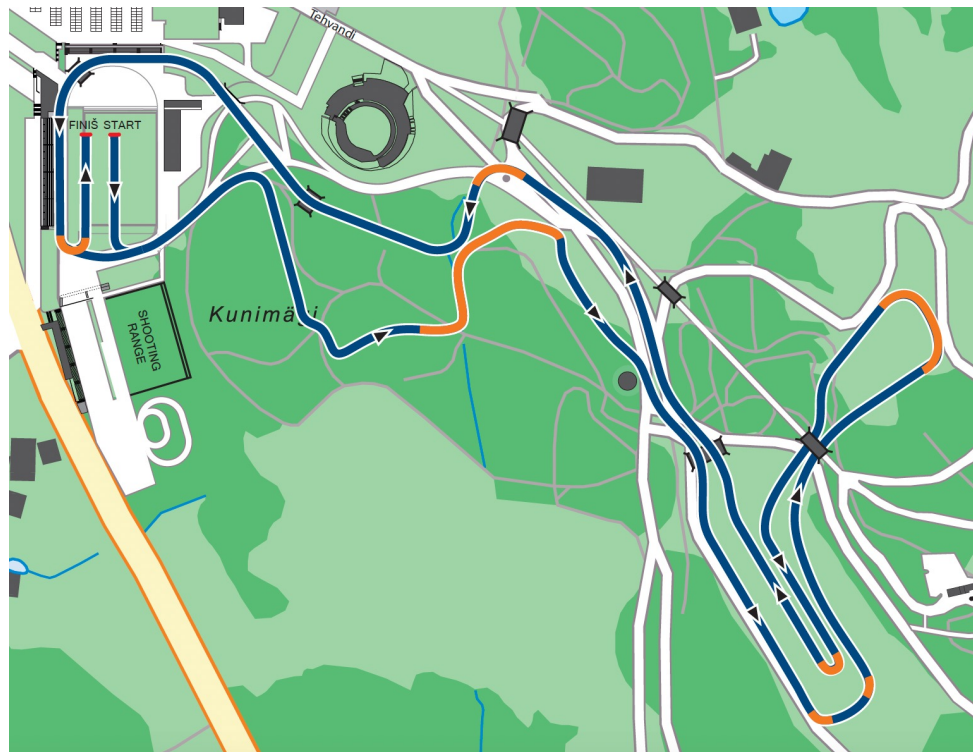
STADIUM

3,3 km course will be skied 6 times

- **SATURDAY**
 - 2 set of tracks on the course
 - Finish 4 corridors
 - Turning technique zones marked with V-boards and branches
- **SATURDAY & SUNDAY**
 - No coaching on the stadium



FLOUR TESTING

- There is **no ski testing** before race on **Saturday**. Skies are tested after the race.
- No Kick wax zone on Saturday
- **Pre-race testing on Sunday!**
 - Station will be open 45 minutes before race start
 - Skies must be checked in 30 minutes before start time.
- **Stickers for both skies**

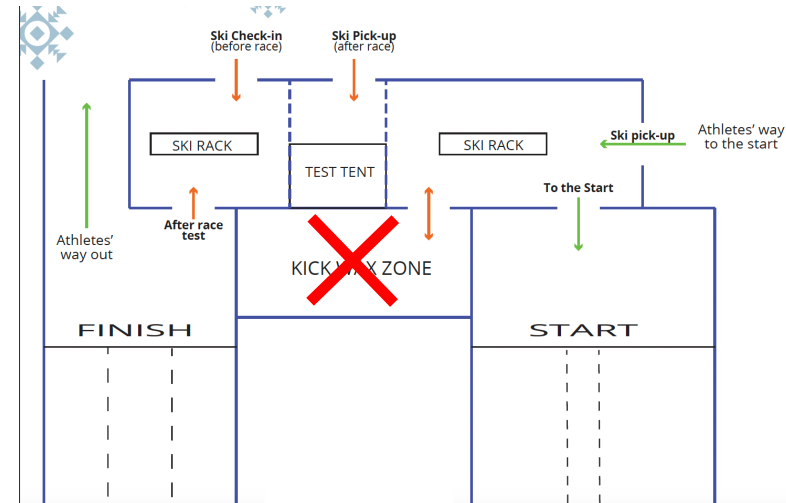

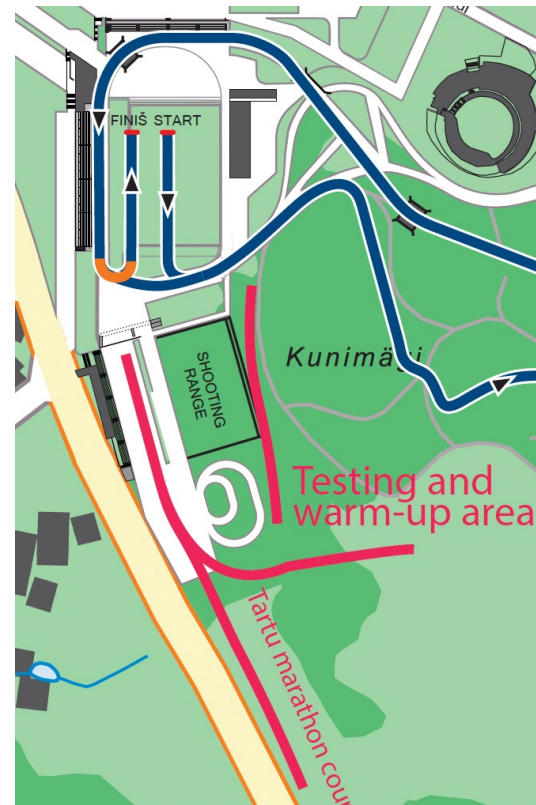

WARM-UP and SKI TESTING

- Testing area will be open from 7:00. Lights will be turned behind shooting range
- **There is new testing section on first uphill on Sprint course with 4 tracks**
- Competition course is open at 9.00 in the morning for Official training and warm-up
- Course will be closed 5 minutes before by forerunners
- Ski testing is allowed only on testing course
- Training is possible on marathon track



COURSE PREPARATION AND GROOMING

- The Course will be prepared for the competition late in the evening
- Markings will be done in the morning before 9
- In Finish 4 corridors (On Sunday 3 corridors)
- Saturday turning technique zone are marked with V-boards and branches
- No coaching on stadium

- Classical Technique competition (ICR 310.2.2) – skiing technique will be controlled.
- The pole length will be controlled (ICR 343.8.1)
