# WARM-UP and SKI TESTING

- Competition course is open at 9.00 in the morning for warm-up.
- Course will be closed 5 minutes before first start by fore-runners.
- Between qualification and finals, it's possible to warm-up on racing track (only athletes proceeded in finals)
- Ski testing is allowed only on testing course
- Training is possible on 3,3 km course and marathon track.



# COURSE PREPARATION AND GROOMING

- The Course will be prepared for the competition late in the evening
- In Start 6+1 tracks (separate track for qualification)
- On the course 4 tracks
- In Finish 4 corridors
- **Tracks from first uphill deeper part will be removed for race**
- There is only one technique zone and marked with V-boards
- No coaching on stadium and downhill
  - No coaching zones are marked with signs

# GENERAL INFORMATION FROM TD

- Classical Technique competition (ICR 310.2.2) – skiing technique will be controlled.
- In qualification, there will be diagonal zone (ICR310.2.2.2) and it will be controlled – IN HEATS NOT.
- The pole length will be controlled (ICR 343.8.1)
- Heat Start procedure (ICR 315.5)
- Take your start position – Set – Bang... be patient NO false starts, please.
- Protests are not accepted during sprint heats, only after finals (ICR 325.6.2)
- Competitors who receive a second written reprimand in the same season will be automatically disqualified. (ICR 352.2.3)
