there will be v-boards, course is divided with v-boards !!

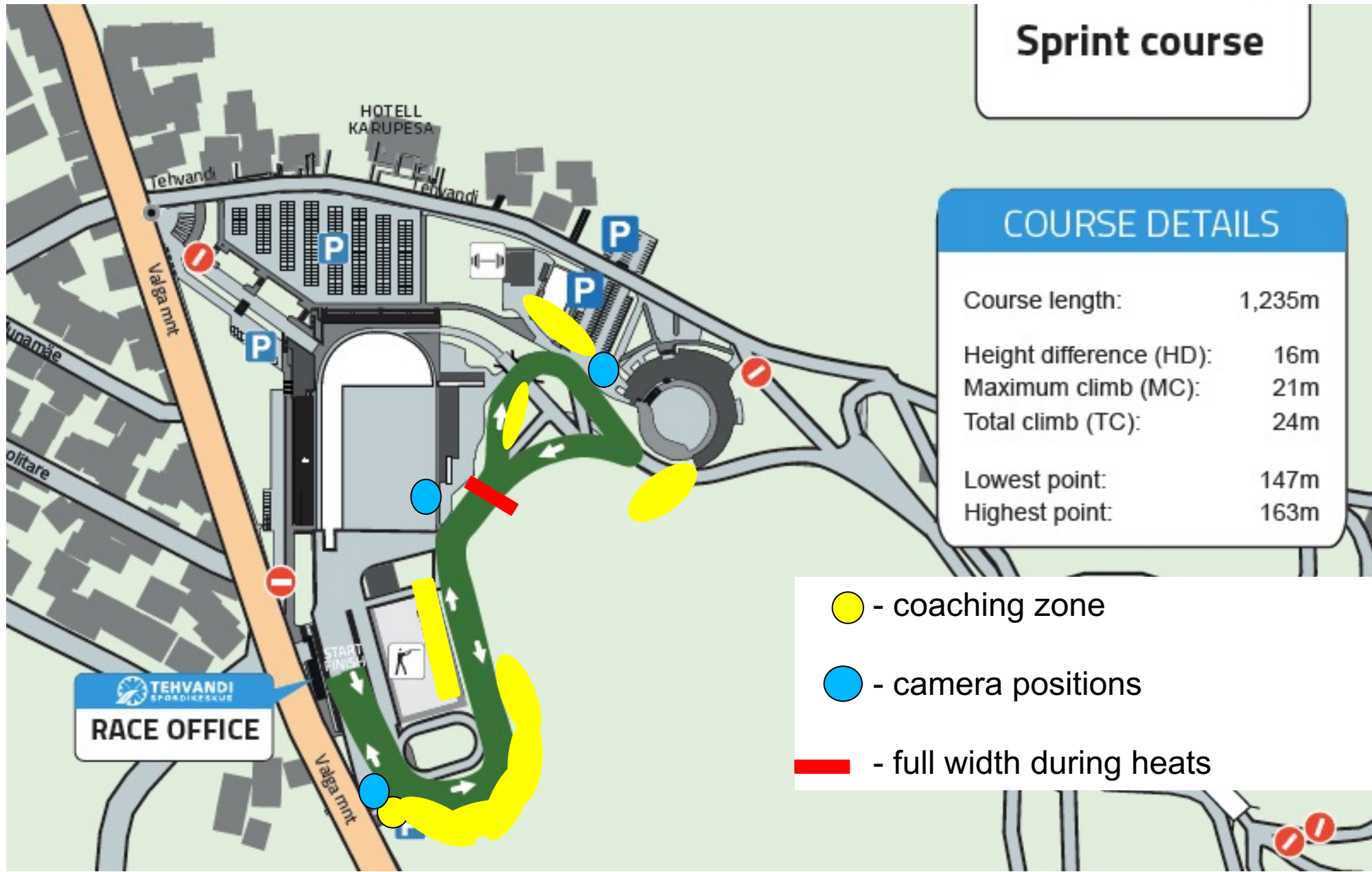


COURSE MARKING FINALS

Coaching zones

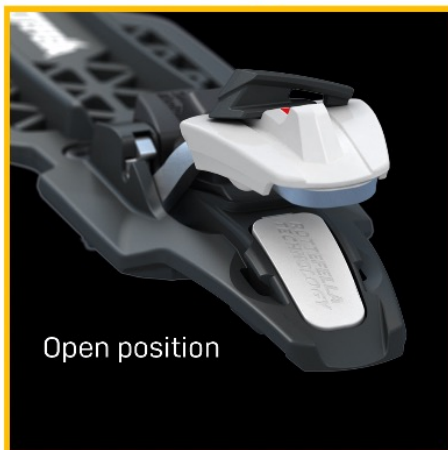

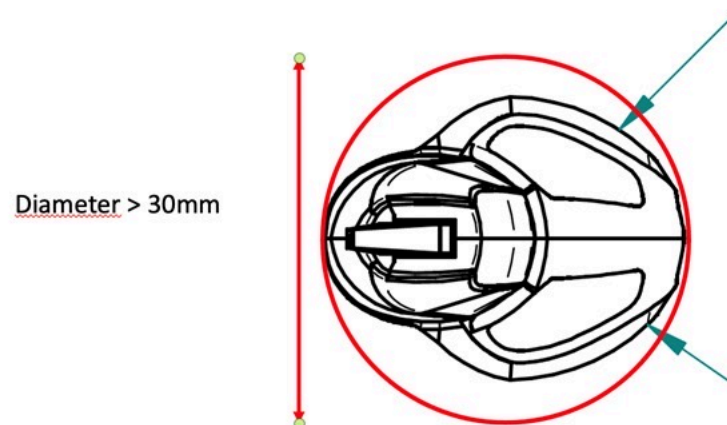
- New security lock

Cross-Country ski poles with Cross-Country skiing tips must be used. Alternatively poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥ 30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips.
